The Winery & Vineyards

Field Stone is a family owned winery and vineyard estate which produces about ten thousand cases of genuinely handcrafted wines each year. We are located in Northern California's Sonoma County approximately seventy miles north of San Francisco just off Highway 128 in the heart of the wine country between the towns of Healdsburg and Calistoga. The viticultural area of our estate is Sonoma County's Alexander Valley, one of America's most celebrated winegrowing regions. Since the late 1960's, when we planted our first modern vineyards, we have been known to such winemakers as André Tchelistcheff, Zelma Long, and Mike Grgich as one of Alexander Valley's premiere grape growing estates. Our Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot and Petite Sirah vineyards have set the standard for what many today call the distinctive "Alexander Valley style".

The winery itself is a unique underground facility carved into a picturesque hillside topped by giant oaks. The name "Field Stone" was derived from the striking, rough-hewn entrance facade built of field stones unearthed during construction in 1976. When visiting Field Stone's tasting room you enter an arched main entrance and wind your way through oak barrels and the enticing smell of ageing and fermenting wine (along with a smile and "hello" from our winemaking crew). The redwood panelled tasting room is truly unique, and its friendly service to visitors and customers is the envy of the industry. Since 1987 Field Stone has been selected annually as one of the "Top Ten Tasting Rooms in Napa and Sonoma Counties" from over two hundred assessed by a respected national survey group. Proud of this coveted award, we are eager to show each visitor what makes a Field Stone visit so unique and enjoyable.
