Field Stone is known for its ability to maintain consistent high quality throughout its product line year after year. Its successful sales base and its intense, dedicated focus on each of its wines has enabled it to go beyond the usual one or two wine production attempted by many small wineries. Conceived as a small estate family winery in the European tradition, each year Field Stone produces select quantities of the following red and white varietal wines. From our estate: Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Sangiovese, Rosé of Sangiovese, Century Old Vine Petite Sirah, Syrah, Viognier, and a New World style Petite Sirah Vintage Port. In addition, each year we produce selected quantities of Sauvignon Blanc from Jim Reed's neighboring Redwood Ranch and Chardonnay from Bob Hopkins' River Ranch in the Russian River appellation.

Over the years, Field Stone's Cabernet wines have been ranked by Robert Parker and other national and international wine critics as among the very best produced in America. Its Old Vine Petite Sirah (from our vineyard planted in 1894) has often been cited by winemakers and critics as the finest produced of its type in California. All of our limited production varieties, both red and white, have consistently garnered many gold and silver medals over the last thirty years and the highest praise from wine and food critics and reviewers in *Bon Appétit*, *The Wine Spectator*, *The Wine Enthusiast*, *The Wine Advocate*, *Restaurant Wine*, *Wine & Spirits*, *San Francisco Chronicle*, *Press Democrat* and others.

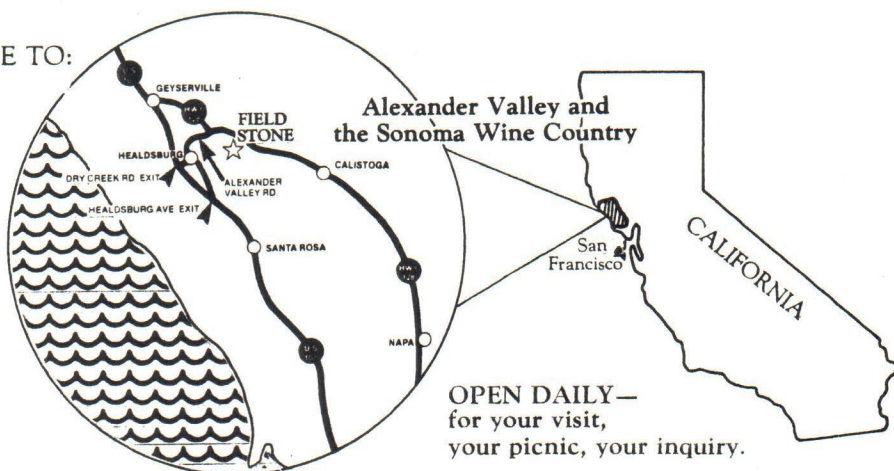
Getting in Touch
